YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox outlasted Harrisburg in 10 innings last night with a 3-2 victory for the club's third consecutive win. **Austin Overn** scored the game's first run with a straight steal of home and drove in the game's final run with an RBI single to left-center. **Ethan Anderson** launched his first Double-A homer. Chesapeake had just one hit through the first nine innings. The bullpen of **Gerald Ogando, Carter Baumler, Zane Barnhart** and **Tyson Neighbors** combined for 7.1 scoreless innings.

SOMEWHERE OVERN THE RAINBOW

OF Austin Overn is the first player in Double-A this season to steal at least three bases and deliver a walk-off hit in the same game and just the third Double-A player to accomplish both since 2005. The Orioles No. 30 prospect has reached base in 18 of 22 games played since joining the Baysox on August 5. Overn leads the Orioles' farm with 61 stolen bases and is fourth in walks drawn (59).

CREED CRUSHES

After starting 2-for-18 in his first five games, C Creed Willems was red hot to finish out August. The 22-year-old slashed .320/.407/.660 with two doubles, five homers and 16 RBI in the final 12 games of the month. Willems' .515 slugging percentage in August was seventh-best in the Eastern League and his .869 OPS was 10th-best.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE

OF **Thomas Sosa** homered in his first Double-A at-bat with a two-run shot off Nationals No. 11 prospect LHP Jake Bennett on Tuesday. **Sosa joins IF Aron Estrada and IF Jeremiah Jackson as the only three Baysox this season to homer in their Baysox debuts.** The 20-year-old was promoted from High-A Aberdeen on Tuesday after just 47 games played this season with the IronBirds.

ESTRADA IS ELECTRIC

IF Aron Estrada made his return from the injured list on Tuesday after missing the last nine games due to right quad discomfort. After hitting five homers in 81 games with High-A Aberdeen, the Orioles No. 25 prospect has blasted already five bombs in 19 games with Double-A Chesapeake. The 20-year-old led High-A Aberdeen in AVG, H, 2B, 3B, RBI and OBP at the time of his promotion on July 29.

SMOOTH LIKE BUTTER

IF Brandon Butterworth has reached base in 22 of his first 24 starts with hits in 17 of those contests since joining the Baysox after the trade deadline. Seven of his last nine hits have gone for extra bases (six doubles, one triple). The 23-year-old had the sixth-most extra-base hits (35) and the most triples (7) in the Midwest League while with High-A Fort Wayne (SD) before being traded to the Orioles.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Over the last four games, **Chesapeake's bullpen has allowed just one earned run over its last 18.2 innings pitched (0.49 ERA).** Baysox relievers have struck out 605 batters this season, which is third-most in the Eastern League.

SIZING UP THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators - Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals - are 30-27 in the second half, three games out of playoff position in the Southwest, and seek their first playoff berth since 2019. Harrisburg's active roster includes six of the Nationals' top 30 prospects (MLB.com) - RHP Jarlin Susana (No. 3), LHP Alex Clemmey (No. 5), SS Seaver King (No. 7), LHP Jake Bennett (No. 11), C Caleb Lomavita (No. 12), and LHP Jackson Kent (No. 20).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Erik Tolman makes his sixth Double-A start after joining the team on August 5 from High-A Wilmington. After missing all of last season with a dislocated knee and torn ACL suffered in August 2023, Tolman began the year in Single-A Fredericksburg before earning promotion to Wilmington. Primarily in a bulk relief role, he posted a 2.91 ERA in 55.2 innings pitched for the Blue Rocks. The Irvine, Calif. native was drafted by the Nationals in 2021 out of Arizona State.

2025: Pitched Double-A high 6.2 innings and gave up 3 R (2 ER) on 4 H with 7 K to earn win in most recent start on 8/28 @ REA. Has earned win in last three starts. Leads team in K (91) and is 2nd in IP (85.0). 2nd-most IP (110.0) and 3rd-most K (128) in Orioles system. Holds a 3.95 ERA in second half and held a 3.33 ERA (10 ER/27.0 IP) in month of August. Recorded a 4.91 ERA in month of July after finishing month of June with a 2.49 ERA (8th-best in EL), a 0.74 WHIP (2nd-best in EL) and a .135 BAA. Named EL Pitcher of the Week for 6/10-6/15 after 6.0 shutout, one-hit innings and 6 K on 6/13 vs HBG. First Baysox player this season to be named EL Player/Pitcher of the Week. Threw 11.2 consecutive scoreless innings to start month of June. Pitched 5.2 shutout innings and struck out six in Double-A debut on 5/16 vs AKR. Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 5/13. Started season in High-A Aberdeen. Made six starts and posted a 3.60 ERA with 37 K over 25 innings pitched over 10 walks allowed. Struck out seven batters in each of his final three starts with IronBirds before earning promotion. At time of promotion, was tied for 10th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts.

2024: Spent first season in Minors between Single-A Delmarva as a starter and High-A Aberdeen as a tandem reliever. Struck out 90 batters in 73.2 innings to a 1.59 ERA. Began season in Delmarva. Recorded a 1.49 ERA in 48.1 IP with 57 K. Missed a month of season from 5/15-6/14 due to injury. Promoted to Aberdeen on 8/1. In seven outings, posted a 1.78 ERA in 25.1 innings with 33 strikeouts over just three walks. Excelled at home: 0.69 ERA in 11 home outings.

Career Notes: Did not pitch in '23 after getting drafted.

College: Pitched three seasons at Seattle primarily as a starter. Recorded a career 6.37 ERA in 47 outings with 143 K in 195.0 IP. Ranks 6th all-time in program history in wins (12), while also ranking top-10 in starts, complete games, and strikeouts. Tied Tarik Skubal for Seattle's single-game strikeout record with 12 against Utah Valley.

Personal: Drafted by the Orioles in the 11th round of the 2023 Draft out of Seattle University. First Redhawk drafted since 2019 and fourth Redhawk to be drafted by Orioles. Native of Seattle, WA. Family is from Mexico. Lived in Mexico when he was 3 years old and played Little League there where his uncle served as head coach.

Manager

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League BaseballTM teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
